How does the voucher program work?

Purchased vouchers are approved for use at the Allegheny Spay/Neuter Clinic in Woodland or Centre Hall and All Pets Vet Clinic in State College ONLY. The voucher covers spay/neuter surgery costs for cats, but does NOT guarantee any additional medical care.

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PAWS paid cat vouchers are available (for both feral/barn and non-feral cats) to any non-Centre County residents.

Your next steps

- Mail, fax, or email your completed application to PAWS ‘
- Payment must be included to be processed
- Wait for your application to be processed and for the voucher to be mailed back to you
- Make an appointment with All Pets Vet Clinic or Allegheny Spay/Neuter Clinic

Restrictions

- Non-Centre County residents are eligible for vouchers for cats (feral/barn or non-feral) only.
- Vouchers may only be used at All Pets Vet Clinic or Allegheny Spay/Neuter Clinic in Woodland or Centre Hall.
- All feral/barn cats must have their ear tipped at the time of surgery.
- Applications must be received in advance of your appointment. Please allow at least 2 weeks for processing of your application. Retroactive vouchers will not be approved. **Vouchers are only valid for 90 days.**
